

Much of the Association's activity during 1993 was related to *Wisconsin HealthNet*, our vision for health care reform in Wisconsin.

Developed and finalized in late 1992, *Wisconsin HealthNet* became the focus of an intensive effort to introduce, position and explain this concept to diverse stakeholders statewide starting in January 1993.

*Wisconsin HealthNet* asks that Wisconsinites re-examine long-held beliefs and biases about health care reform, recognizing that meaningful change cannot be made incrementally and that tinkering with the present system is both futile and divisive.

Significant results are possible only through wholesale restructuring of the system. *Wisconsin HealthNet* charts a course toward that goal and will serve as WHA's guiding beacon as we pursue that course in the future.
