### Sepsis Antibiotic Administration/Compatibility Chart

Always give the following medications first without delay:  
**Aztreonam, Ceftriaxone, Cefepime, Meropenem, Moxifloxacin, Levofloxacin, Piperacillin-Tazobactam and Dexamethasone.**

Co-administer medications as able based on compatibility and number of access sites/lumens.
