Wisconsin Hospitals State PAC & Conduit Exceeds \$350,000, Aggressive 2023 Goal Met

As of Dec. 21, the Wisconsin Hospitals State PAC & Conduit has raised \$359,575, exceeding its aggressive 2023 fundraising goal of \$350,000. To-date, 270 individuals have contributed to the Wisconsin Hospitals PAC & Conduit, 56 of which are first-time contributors in 2023.
