CMS to Host Webinar on 2025 Hospital Price Transparency Requirements

On Oct. 21, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will host a <u>webinar</u> on meeting new hospital price transparency requirements that become effective Jan. 1, 2025. The most recent changes became effective <u>July 1</u>, 2024, which require hospitals to use a standard machine-readable file format that includes some new data elements, such as the negotiated rate methodology and an accuracy and completeness statement. <u>Register here</u>.
