Dr. William Melms, Chief Medical Officer of Marshfield Clinic Health System and Chair of the WHA Physician Leaders Council, welcomed the group and set the tone for the conference.

Shelley Smith of the LAK Group kicked the conference off by discussing tools, techniques and perspectives to excel in authentic leadership. Noting that a title doesn't define a leader, Smith discussed purposeful leadership skills focused on communication, nurturing relationships and helping others understand their value in ensuring organizational success.
