Behavioral health services

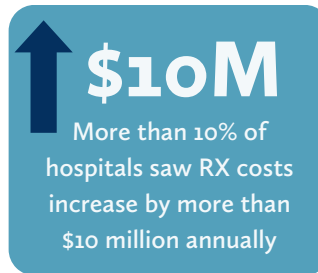


RX remote dispensing sites for rural areas

Drugmakers' Actions are Harming 340B Hospitals

Please protect 340B which supports Wisconsin hospitals and communities.

340B



Costs the federal government nothing and requires no taxpayer support.



Is one of the few tools hospitals have to offset skyrocketing drug costs.



Saves Medicare money by lowering costs for Critical Access Hospitals.

Program Integrity



Hospitals devote significant resources toward complying with federal 340B requirements.

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Protect 340B from Dishonest Attacks

PhRMA "Coalition" Claims do not Match Up with Reality

CLAIM

340B needs to be scaled back to benefit only safety net hospitals.

FACT

Hospitals must be a CAH, cancer/children's hospital, government affiliated, or serve a disproportionate share of Medicaid patients to qualify.

CLAIM

340B discounts must go toward patient care.

FACT

They already do. See the reverse page for examples of what hospitals do with savings from 340B.

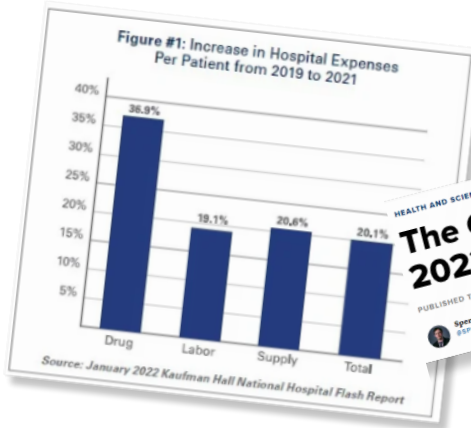
CLAIM

340B needs more transparency.

FACT

HRSA already performs 200 rigorous audits of 340B entities each year, compared to 5 drug manufacturer audits.

While drug companies continue to grow record profits, hospitals are facing one of the hardest times in recent memory - with stagnant revenues from Medicare and Medicaid and exploding costs.

DO:

Support legislation to protect 340B, such as the PROTECT 340B Act of 2023 introduced by Reps. Dusty Johnson (R-SD) and Abigail Spanerger (D-VA)

DON'T:

Please do not support H.R. 3290 (Buschon - R-IN). This legislation adds duplicative and unnecessary reporting requirements that would increase compliance costs for hospitals with no patient benefit.
