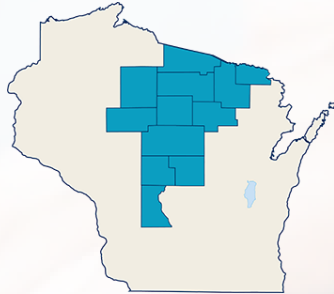

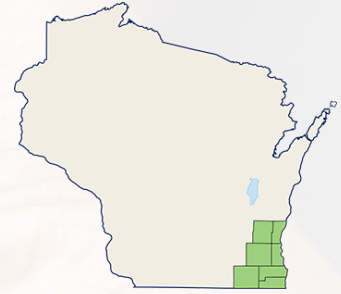
Community Benefits FY 2022 By Region

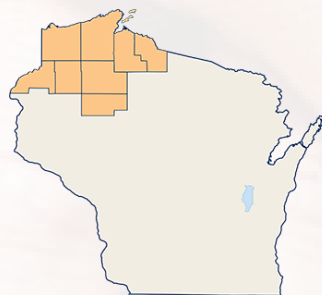

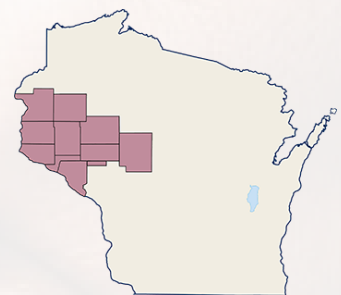

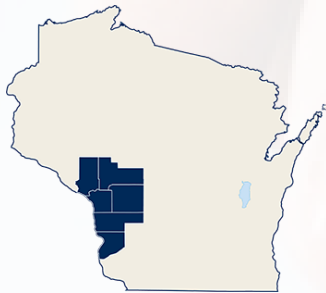
